July 17, 2017

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Grogan called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL: Present were Mayor W. James Grogan, Councilmember Angie Smith, Councilmember Caleb Phillips, Councilmember Jason Power, Councilmember Mike Sosebee, City Attorney Dana Miles, City Clerk Bonnie Warne (absent), City Manager Bob Bolz, Deputy City Clerk Beverly Banister, Utilities Director Gary Barr, Public Works Manager Trampas Hansard, and Planning Director Casey Majewski.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE: Invocation and pledge was led by J. Power.

AGENDA: Motion to approve the agenda by: J. Power/M. Sosebee. Vote carried unanimously in favor.

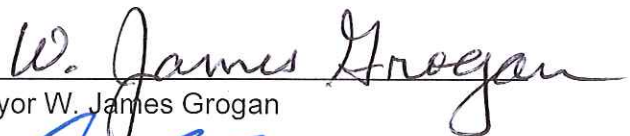
BUSINESS:

Heatherwood Development, Update on Upcoming Subdivisions, Discussion of Future Road Paving Issues: Planning Director Casey Majewski presented a combined power point presentation on all 3 issues. Main points included status and concerns of current developments in process, proposed development and possible future developments. Casey discussed traffic patterns along Maple Street with current, projected and future homes with possible solutions through connectivity. Public Works Manager Trampas Hansard addressed Council regarding road maintenance issues for repairs offering a 5 year plan and estimated costs. Trampas asked Council how the staff should proceed; Council requested a copy of the presentation in order to consider the options.

Discussion on Peddler's License: Planning Director Casey Majewski discussed the draft of the Peddler's License with additions including vendors for the potential farmer's market to obtain a yearlong vendor's license, door to door or stationary vendors required to submit a background check along with a detailed application to be completed and the addition of food trucks requiring a separation from a restaurant or food and beverage establishment of 200 feet and they will also be prevented from setting up within 50 feet of an intersection.

ADJOURNMENT: With there being no further business to attend to, the meeting closed and adjourned at 5:39 p.m. by: J. Power/M. Sosebee. Vote carried unanimously in favor.

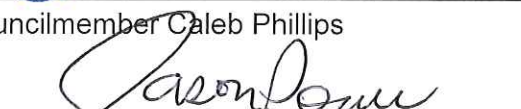

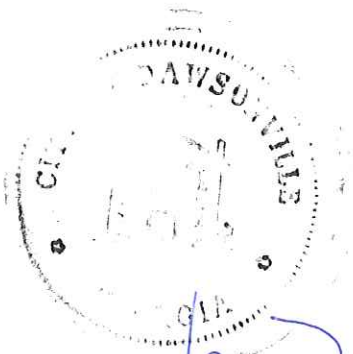


Councilmember Caleb Phillips
