*Message from the City Manager ...*

**WATER ARE YOU DOING ABOUT WATER?**

This play on words should be a reminder not to take our drinking water for granted. Currently, Dawson County is under a Level 1 Drought Response. However, NOAA is predicting unfavorable forecasts for rain across sections of Georgia, including Dawson County for the next few months. When this is coupled with deficits in rainfall for the last six months, we could face a prolonged drought.

As a community, we need to voluntarily be more water aware. Did you know a leak from a ¼" waterline equals a loss of almost 15,000 gallons of water/day, and a leaky commode can lose over 200 gallons per day? Add 12 drops of food coloring into the toilet tank and if color appears in the bowl one hour later, your toilet is leaking. Replace old equipment like toilets, dishwashers, and washing machines with more efficient ones. Take shorter showers, replace showerheads with more efficient models. If it takes a long time for the hot water to reach the shower, use it as an opportunity to collect water for other uses, such as watering plants. Fix leaky faucets. A faucet leaking 60 drops per minute will waste 192 gallons per month. Install efficient faucets and faucet aerators. Wash only full loads of laundry. Limit the use of your garbage disposal. If washing dishes by hand, fill the sink with water for washing and rinsing instead of a continuously running faucet. Avoid using running water to thaw food.

Outside, do some research and use water-wise landscaping principles. Collect rainwater in barrels and use for plant irrigation. Properly use mulch to conserve moisture. Sweep outside surfaces with a broom instead of a hose. Use car washes that recycle their water. Set the mower blades 2-3 inches higher, allowing the grass to shade the soil and improve moisture retention helping grass survive. These are just a few examples of ways to save water, a precious gift from God.
